Despite all the changes the world has undergone in the past several millennia, the coldest place on earth remains Antarctica. A recent discovery revealed that tiny valleys near the top of Antarctica's ice sheet reached temperatures of minus 100 degrees Celsius — that's minus 148 degrees Fahrenheit — in the winter. This is actually colder than recorded in a 2013 study.

Oymyakon is a village in the Yakutia region of Russia. The village is the coldest place on the planet that has been inhabited by people. The village received the title of the coldest place after the temperatures dropped to −67.7 °C (−89.9 °F) on February 6, 1933.
